Rules/Regulations

1. An exhibitor must be a resident of Lake or Mendocino County and their pumpkin must have been grown in these counties. Each specimen must be grown and fully cared for by the exhibitor.
2. An exhibitor/family may be allowed to weigh no more than two pumpkins. Only one of the two pumpkins will be allowed to enter the weigh-off for contest money.
3. All entries must be received with this form and \$5.00 entry fee.
4. Your pumpkin must be healthy and undamaged with vine trimmed to maximum of one inch of stem. No foreign material may be included in weighing. Large pumpkins are any fruit yellow to orange in color. Note: Giant squash are any fruit green or grey or any other color or combination of color. It is possible for a squash to grow on your pumpkin vine. **Squash are not eligible.**
5. All entries must be received during the hours of 10:00 am and 1:00pm, Saturday, October 8, 2011.
6. The top fifteen winners will receive prize money and agree to have their pumpkin displayed at the Safeway parking lot Oct. 8-15 and be on the special float for Sat. Oct 15th . Prize pumpkins must be picked up Sunday, Oct. 16th at the Alex R Thomas Plaza.
7. All award winning pumpkins will be on display at PumpkinFest Oct 15th & 16th.
8. **Awards presentation will be held at end of weigh-off (approx 1:15pm). Growers should be present.**
9. An exhibitor must sign an entry/consent form to receive recognition and participate in prize money, and agree to allow display of entry. (All other entries must be picked up by 2:00pm on the day of the weigh-off.)
10. In the event of a tie, pumpkins of equal weight will be declared co-winners and the cash award will be divided equally.
11. Decisions of judges are final.
12. For large entries, pallets are recommended. Growers are responsible for preventing scraping, bruising, and for removal of entries.

Rules/Regulations

3. All entries must be received with this form and \$5.00 entry fee.
4. Your pumpkin must be healthy and undamaged with vine trimmed to maximum of one inch of stem. No foreign material may be included in weighing. Large pumpkins are any fruit yellow to orange in color. Note: Giant squash are any fruit green or grey or any other color or combination of color. It is possible for a squash to grow on your pumpkin vine. **Squash are not eligible.**
5. All entries must be received during the hours of 10:00 am and 1:00pm, Saturday, October 9, 2010.
6. The top fifteen winners will receive prize money and agree to have their pumpkin displayed at the Safeway parking lot Oct. 9-16 and be on the special float for Sat. Oct 16. Prize pumpkins must be picked up Sunday, Oct. 17th at the Alex R Thomas Plaza.
7. All award winning pumpkins will be on display at PumpkinFest Oct 16th & 17th.
8. **Awards presentation will be held at end of weigh-off (approx 1:15pm). Growers should be present.**
9. An exhibitor must sign an entry/consent form to receive recognition and participate in prize money, and agree to allow display of entry. (All other entries must be picked up by 2:00pm on the day of the weigh-off.)
10. In the event of a tie, pumpkins of equal weight will be declared co-winners and the cash award will be divided equally.
11. Decisions of judges are final.
12. For large entries, pallets are recommended. Growers are responsible for preventing scraping, bruising, and for removal of entries.
