The Power Content Label is an annual report that shows where your electricity was generated during the calendar year and how it compares to the State of California's power mix. Ukiah's power mix meets and exceeds California's requirements for clean power.

Ukiah's renewable energy comes from (1) small hydroelectric from Lake Mendocino, New Spicer Meadows and other small hydroelectric projects throughout Central California (2) Geothermal from The Geysers and (3) two solar projects (offsetting utility loads) both located in Lake County. An additional 37% of our power mix came from large hydroelectric projects in Calaveras and Central Valley (California does not count power from large hydroelectric dams as renewable).
