

PATHS, OPEN SPACE, AND CREEKS COMMISSION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Attached is an application for appointment to the City of Ukiah Paths, Open Space, and Creeks Commission. Please review the application questions carefully, note the submittal deadline, and feel free to list answers to the questions on an additional sheet of paper. An application filled out incorrectly or incomplete could be basis for denial. Applications submitted after the submittal deadline will not be accepted.

The Paths, Open Space, and Creeks Commission consist of five (5) members as follows: three (3) members must reside inside the Ukiah City limits and two (2) may reside within Mendocino County. Please check with the City Clerk at 707-463-6217 to learn what the membership requirements are for the vacant position(s).

The Commission shall have the power and duty to recommend and advise on the efficient implementation of the open space and conservation element of the Ukiah general plan; efficient implementation of the pathway sections of the transportation element of the Ukiah general plan, and procedure and funding mechanisms for acquisition, preservation, restoration, and effective stewardship of City paths, open space, and creeks. The Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council.

The Ukiah Paths, Open Space, and Creeks Commission is appointed by the Ukiah City Council for a three (3) year term. The Commission meets the third Tuesday of each month for regular meetings. The Director of Planning and Community Development is the liaison to the Commission and prepares the agenda for the meetings.
