Police Department Sex Offender Registrant Information

You can telephone the California Department of Justice to find out if someone you know is one of California's registered sex offenders who has victimized children.

Anyone who believes that a child may be at risk for any reason may call. This includes parents, organizations, non-profit groups, or businesses with employees who interact with children.

The hours of operation are 9:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The cost is \$10 per phone call for information on two people. The charge will appear on your next phone bill automatically.

YOU:

- Must be 18 Years or Older
- Will be asked to identify yourself
- Must have a reasonable suspicion that a child is at risk

YOU NEED:

- Person's Name
- Address or
- Birth date or Social Security Number or
- California Drivers License Number

If you don't have the above information you need to provide the person's name and at least five of the following identifiers:

- Height
- Weight
- Hair Color
- Eye Color
- Ethnicity/Race
- Description of scars, tattoos or birthmarks

It is illegal to use this information to commit a crime against a registrant or to engage in illegal discrimination or harassment.
