City of Ukiah public hours will change effective the work week of July 11, 2011, and will include closure of City Hall every Friday beginning July 15, 2011. The current 43 hours open to the public will be reduced to 38 hours per week. Due entirely to the financial situation of the City, employees have agreed to a 10% reduction in salary in the form of a 36-hour work week, which will consist of four 9-hour days, Monday through Thursday each week. This reduction in hours will apply to non-public safety personnel only. **Public hours in the Civic Center and Annex offices will be from 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday, a total of 38 hours per week for the public to conduct business at City Hall.**

This reduction in pay and resulting schedule change during fiscal year 2011/12 will allow existing public services to remain in place while the City Council conducts a review of all services in order to set priorities for next year's budget.

As we move to this new schedule the City Council and staff are prepared to work with the public to resolve any service needs and issues that may arise. Please feel free to contact City Manager Jane Chambers at (707) 463-6213 with any concerns or questions.
